Location

The Flaminio district is considered the cultural center of Rome, although its origins are very modest compared to its current reputation. Born in 1921, the neighborhood owes its name to the consular road that crosses it, Via Flaminia. Uninhabited until the 19th century due to the frequent overflows of the Tiber river, it went through several historical phases of evolution, with a progressive urbanization during the fascist period until it became profoundly transformed after the end of the Second World War with the assignment of the Olympic Games of the 1960 in Rome.
